ABSTRACT GUIDELINES

Abstracts that reflect all scientific focus areas spanning the clinical translational continuum are welcome, including basic and pre-clinical science, clinical and population science, dissemination and implementation science.

WHO SHOULD SUBMIT

Any surgical investigator in training, including postdoctoral and clinical fellows, residents and medical students. Individuals may submit more than one abstract, but each author may only have one oral presentation.

ABSTRACT FORMAT

- A 250-word abstract that presents a concise summary of research completed or in progress.
- The structured abstract must include a brief title, introduction, methods, results and conclusions as separate paragraphs.
- A one-page table or figure may be submitted, which does not count toward the 250 maximum word count.
- Successful abstracts will include a strong statement of hypothesis, descriptive methods, appropriate statistical analysis and clearly stated results.
- This research may have been presented previously at a local or national meeting, but it may not have been previously published or be in press.

SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACT

Submission of abstracts is by email only. Please note at the heading of the Abstract the following information: 1) name of investigator-in-training, 2) the supporting Principal Investigator, 3) Departmental laboratory.
