I-376 Closure: Preparing for Traffic Impacts From a Business Continuity Perspective

The upcoming I-376 closure is expected to create significant traffic disruptions and detours throughout the Pittsburgh area over the next several weeks. As a result, commute times may increase and travel routes may change.

Departments are encouraged to discuss potential impacts and identify strategies to maintain operations. Proactive planning can help reduce disruptions, maintain operations, and support employees as the region adjusts to temporary traffic changes.

UPitt Ready Questions to Consider:

Do you have a way to communicate with employees?

- Ensure employee contact information is current.
- Determine how updates or changes to reporting instructions will be communicated.
- Identify who employees should contact if they anticipate being late or are unable to report to work due to traffic conditions.

Are there alternate University locations where work could be completed if travel to the primary worksite is not feasible?

Have expectations for remote accesss, technology, and availability been communicated?

Are there critical functions that require on-site coverage, and if so, is backup coverage identified?

Have employees identified alternate routes?

- Encourage staff to monitor traffic conditions and review potential detour routes before leaving for work.
